William Clavson, Swedish-American balladeer and guitarist, will be on stage at Kresge Auditorium, M.I.T., Friday evening, November 10, at 8:30 p.m. Tickets for the concert, which is the second in a series sponsored by the M.I.T. Choral Society, may be obtained for \$3 by calling UNiversity 4-6900, extension 2910, or writing the Guest Artist Series, Box Office, Kresge Auditorium, M.I.T. Tickets will also be on sale daily from noon to 2 p.m. in the main lobby of Building 10, M.I.T.

Mr. Clavson is noted for his interpretations of numerous foreign folk songs as well as ballads in the American tradition. This "viking of song," as poet Carl Sandburg called him, has roamed the world performing and adding to his bag of songs. By drawing from his extensive repertoire, the trilingual tenor styles each performance to suit the audience, as he will Friday evening at M.I.T.

The Dave Brubeck Quartet will round out the 1961-62 Guest Artist Series with a concert in the Spring, at a date to be announced.
