Approximately 660 members of the Class of 1966 received degrees during Commencement at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Friday, June 10. About 583 graduate students received advanced degrees. Dr. Julius A. Stratton, who will retire at the end of June, delivered his last Commencement speech as President of M.I.T. A member of the Class of 1923, Dr. Stratton was a professor of physics, provost and chancellor, before becoming Acting President in 1957 and President in 1959.

The Commencement program included military commissioning exercises on June 9, senior class social activities, and the traditional outdoor luncheon and President's reception on the lawn in front of M.I.T. for the graduates and their families.
