Students from 54 foreign countries received degrees Friday (June 10) from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Many families and relatives of the 175 foreign degree recipients came to the United States to witness the awarding of degrees at the 100th commencement exercises of the scientific and technological Institute in Cambridge, Massachusetts.

The foreign students were among approximately 1200 students receiving graduate and undergraduate degrees. Dr. Julius A. Stratton, who will retire at the end of June, delivered his last commencement speech as president of M.I.T. and personally presented the diplomas to each degree recipient. Dr. James R. Killian, Jr., Chairman of the M.I.T. Corporation, presided over the ceremonies.
